### **Doctoral Degree:**

**Prerequisite: Master's Degree**  
**Program requirements: 30,000 words**  
**Theological Dissertation**  
**References: 30 minimum**

**Phase One:** Complete a Theses/Dissertation Topic Request Form and submit to Carolina University of Theology (CUT) to get staff approval prior to starting the project. When completing the Theses/Dissertation Request Form, be sure to include the Title of your Dissertation, a complete outline, and the purpose of your dissertation.

**Phase Two:** Obtain the necessary books/manuscripts and other research materials. Furthermore, your Dissertation should include the Title, version or translation of Bible used, a Title page, blank page or copyright page, a Table of Content, list of illustrations if needed, list of tables if used, preface, acknowledgement, glossary, introduction, chapter, appendix if need and bibliography. Footnotes must be placed at the bottom of or at least must begin on the page where they are referred.

**PLEASE NOTE: ANY SCRIPTURES QUOTED THROUGHOUT YOUR DISSERTATION WILL NOT BE USED AS PART OF TOTAL WORD COUNT REQUIREMENT.**

**Phase Three:** Your final dissertation should be as near to perfection as possible. Points will be deducted for each spelling and grammatical error found in your paper. Additionally, CUT requires that your Dissertation paper be typed and professionally bound.

A member of the CUT Staff will review, evaluate, and grade your final paper. Upon successful completion of this process, you will earn your degree.

**Note:** The Dissertation should be written in accordance with the book: "A Manual for Writers for Term Papers, Theses and Dissertations" by Kate L. Turabian, Sixth Edition, ISBN 0-226-81627-3.
